Database caching via **disk** is currently **enabled**.

To rebuild the database cache use the operation.

General

Don't cache queries for logged in users
Enabling this option is recommended to maintain default WordPress behavior.

Advanced

Maximum lifetime of cache objects: seconds
Determines the natural expiration time of unchanged cache items. The higher the value, the larger the cache.

Garbage collection interval: seconds
If caching to disk, specify how frequently expired cache data is removed. For busy sites, a lower value is best.

Never cache the following pages:
Always ignore the specified pages / directories.

Ignored query stems:
Do not cache queries that contain these terms. Any entered prefix (set in wp-config.php) will be replaced with current database prefix (default: wp_). Query stems can be identified using debug mode.
